DESPITE FIRE THREATS, CALM, or Child Abuse and Listening Mediation managed to open the doors to yet another Design Showcase home. After about eight

months of renovation, Casa Robles, returned to its original Spanish-Colonial style, welcomed CALM donors, members, and supporters last week for a fundraising Sunset Soirée.

"We are so excited about this year's Design Showcase," shared Meredith Scott, Event Committee Co-chair and CALM Board President. "CALM is celebrating its 40th anniversary and what better way to celebrate 40 years of helping children in the community than with this beautiful design home."

The search for the Design Showcase home began last summer. "We received a call from the home owners showing interest in participating... I drove to the house, took a peek through the gate, and thought 'oh my gosh this is the design house,'" recalled Scott. Casa Robles is a knoll top

hacienda designed by famed architect Chester Carjola, who in 1939 helped turn the old Post Office into what is today- the Santa Barbara Museum of Art. The 4,500 square foot home sits on a two-acre garden of bougainvillea, Specimen Oaks, and graceful palms on the Riviera.

"We had an exceptional team that worked hard and managed to pull it off despite the five day Jesusita Fire evacuation," shared Scott.

The more than 200 attendees were treated to wine, cocktails, hors doeuvres, and breathtaking views

in the beautiful garden/patio overlooking Santa Barbara. The gala allowed CALM supporters to preview the newly renovated home before it opens to the public. Casa Robles showcases the areas top talent and the latest trends in interior design, architecture, and landscape design. Tours run Wednesday through Sunday from 11am to 4pm through June 28th.

After playing a short video, celebrating CALM's 40 years, Cecilia Rodriguez, Executive
